RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO.: 12-TM-26

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe is the parent council for the communities of Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

WHEREAS, the United States, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Eastern Nevada Agency has prepared a Wildland Fire Management Plan (WFMP) for the Four Constituent Bands of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Reservations; and

WHEREAS, a Wildland Fire Management Plan must be adopted prior to implementation of BIA funded wildland fire activities including, silvicultural treatments such as prescribed burning or mechanical fuels treatment projects, Burned Area Emergency Rehabilitation (BAER) and Wildland Fire Prevention and Education; and

WHEREAS, the WEMP prepared by the BIA Eastern Nevada Agency has been reviewed by the Four Constituent Bands of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Tribe Administrative Staff and the Environmental Assessment has determined that a Finding of No Significant Impact will result in the implementation of the Wildland Fire Management Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Tribal Council concur with BIA, Eastern Nevada Agency Fire Management Plan and advocates submission of the associated Environmental Assessment by the Superintendent, Eastern Nevada Agency, for a finding of No Significant Impact.
