RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 10-TM-15

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well being of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; and

WHEREAS, the Elko Band Council has approved a Residential Lease for Dwinda Mendoza at 2291 Indian View Heights with the following land description:

Land Description NENW Quarter, NV Section 10, Township 34 N., Range 55 E., MDM: and

BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to the Constitution of the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Indians of Nevada under Article 4, Section 12(d) leases longer than twelve (12) months require the consent of the Tribal Council; and


THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Tribe recognizes the Elko Band Council Resolution #2010-EBC-18. The Te-Moak Council hereby approves a residential lease for Dwinda Mendoza for a term of twenty-five (25) years with an automatic twenty-five (25) years on the same term and conditions. The Te-Moak Tribe hereby requests the USDI, Bureau of Indian Affairs to execute a residential lease.
