## RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 14-TM-06

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TE-MOAK TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA THAT:**

**WHEREAS**, this organization is a recognized Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic and social welfare and well-being of its members; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council is composed of four (4) constituent Bands, Elko, Battle Mountain, South Fork and Wells; **and**

**WHEREAS**, the South Fork Band Council by Resolution # 14-SF-04 has approved a need for BIA route #1 maintenance, **and**

**WHEREAS**, Te-Moak Council has reviewed this proposal and finds the proposal has merit and worth funding for the benefit of the South Fork Band, **and**

**WHEREAS**, the South Fork Band Council has further requested \$43,700 for Road Maintenance and has submitted a plan on the expenditures of such funds, **and**


**WHEREAS**, the Te-Moak Council has reviewed South Fork Band Council's road maintenance plan and finds the plan has merit and worth approving for the benefit of the South Fork Band, **and**

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Te-Moak Tribal Council supports the South Fork Band request for \$43,700 for road maintenance, and authorized the Bureau of Indian Affairs to make available and be added to the South Fork Band Council's Road Maintenance contract.


### C-E-R-T-I-F-I-C-A-T-I-O-N
